



Harefield Lodge

Spacious residential home providing care to adults with a learning disability, located in the heart of the community.

- Can accommodate up to nine service users

Located in Portswood, Southampton, Harefield Lodge is a large Victorian house that can accommodate up to nine people with a learning disability and additional needs, including challenging behaviours.

All the residents greatly enjoy a large variety of activities and holidays, including swimming at the Quays, bowling and days out at places of interest, pub lunches, discos, day centres, in addition to their own individual activity timetables.

Service users also enjoy a continued learning programme and as a result regularly visit the local College to undertake courses.

The home, which has recently benefited from a refurbishment, provides flexible accommodation with three bedrooms on the first floor, and four bedrooms and a widely-used sensory room on the top floor.

On the ground floor, there is a large lounge and spacious dining room which encourage greater social interaction between the service users. In addition, there are two further bedrooms, one with its own sitting room, which looks out onto the spacious garden.

The home is staffed 24 hours a day enabling the residents to access the community with their key worker. All staff members at Harefield Lodge are qualified to NVQ standards and receive ongoing training to continually enhance the care they provide to all service users.
