Service users living at Hibernia enjoy an active lifestyle with regular social outings into the local community where they enjoy activities including bowling and visiting the local pub for meals. In addition, regular activities are organised through the ACE programme, where service users enjoy everything from horticulture and arts & craft, through to cooking and visits to the local QE Activity Centre.

The house is staffed 24 hours a day by an experienced and skilled team, whose training meets the needs of the individual. The team at Hibernia strive to provide a comfortable and welcoming environment for all service users, whilst promoting their independence, privacy, dignity and choice.
