- Close to local amenities, including North Kent College

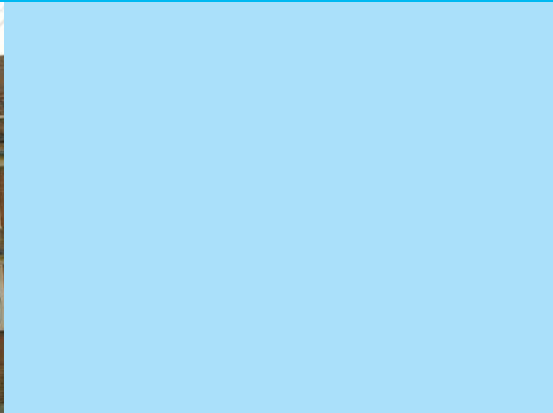
Located in Brompton, near Gillingham, Mansion House provides 24-hour residential care for up to ten people aged 18-65 years with learning disabilities, special needs, challenging behaviours and Autism.

The staff at Mansion House provide a high level of support in order to maximise our service user's full potential and are highly skilled and trained to deliver the highest quality of care.

A key ethos of the home is to promote the independence of service users in all activities and daily living by empowering them with skills and choice, whilst at the same time, protecting their dignity.

Each individual's needs and interests are carefully assessed and Individual Service User Plans are developed and reviewed on a regular basis. Each service user has their own experienced keyworker who is responsible for the needs of the individual and co-ordinates the overall support structure.

At Mansion House, service users are encouraged to take an active role in deciding how they structure their day and are supported by staff as necessary. They are also fully included in the decision making process of the day-to-day running of the home, which is done through meetings, questionnaires and keyworker meetings.



The home is a large Georgian property, which has recently benefited from a refurbishment programme. Situated in a quiet street between Chatham and Gillingham, Mansion House is well connected with transport links to London and the Kent coastline. The Medway towns offer a wealth of leisure facilities including a cinema complex, theatres, leisure centres, bowling and much more.

Service users also have access to North Kent College, which offers a range of courses including cookery, independent living skills, gardening as well as leisure activities. The college also visit the home several times a week to work with service users who are unable to access the college for a variety of reasons. The home also has close links with the local Learning Disability Team in Rochester.
