A residential home for adults with learning disabilities and challenging behaviour in Kent.

Located in the residential heart of Gillingham, Kent, Ridgeway is a large semi-detached property that provides spacious accommodation over three floors to adults with challenging behaviour or learning disabilities.

Ridgeway's service users have many different activities built into their individual care programmes and are actively encouraged and supported to be as independent as possible by learning many domestic and social skills.

The team at Ridgeway specialise in providing 24-hour care to adults with a learning disability and challenging behaviours, with all staff members receiving ongoing NVQ training from the ILG in-house training team to ensure they are fully competent in all aspects of care.

The home provides a comfortable and modern living environment for up to six adults and comprises of a large lounge area where all service users tend to congregate, a dining room, kitchen and two large bathrooms. There is also a bright and airy conservatory.

The enclosed rear garden has an ornamental pond and is situated opposite a leafy park, providing the service users with plenty of open areas in which they can visit and enjoy during the warmer months. The home is also within walking distance of the local shops and public transport is easily accessible.

The service users at Ridgeway enjoy a wide range of activities, including snooker, swimming, art & craft and horticulture. The highly-trained staff at the home work closely with all individuals to ensure they continue pursuing their favourite hobbies and interests, whilst also learning new skills through the activity and education programme.
