Located in St Leonards-on-Sea, East Sussex, St Laurence offers support and accommodation for up to seven people with mild to severe learning disabilities and Autistic Spectrum Disorder.

St Laurence is a large detached Victorian house arranged over three stories and situated in spacious and pleasant south facing gardens. The home also benefits from a large airy conservatory and patio area to the rear of the building that is greatly used by service users and visitors in the warmer months.

The needs of each service user are carefully assessed on an ongoing basis to ensure their needs are being met. Meetings take place each month with each service user to carefully assess their individual care plan to ensure they are receiving the care and support needed, in addition to working towards fulfilling their own personal goals and objectives. In addition, each service user has their own keyworker who is responsible for their day-to-day needs and acts as the co-ordinator for the overall support structure.

St Laurence is well-located close to all local amenities and within a ten minute walk of the mainline train station. This proves to be a convenient access point for many off-site activities, which take place on a regular basis - including swimming, horse riding and art & craft.

The staff at St Laurence are highly trained at NVQ-level in providing quality care to individuals with learning disabilities and Autism.
